
It would take many pages to outline Treacy's coaching successes over these 26 years but the following statistics serve to underscore his coaching acumen

- Coach to 11 NCAA individual champions
- Coach to 13 olympians including Mark Carroll, Sinead Delahunty, Kim Smyth, Rosin McGettigan, Maria Mc Mahon (Davenport) and Martin Fagan
