The Cork County Junior, Senior and Masters Track and Field Championships will take place on Sunday May 9th in the CIT Track in Bishopstown.

Electronic timing will be used.

Athletes may compete in one category only with the following exceptions:

- Junior & Masters Women may also compete as senior in all events with the exception of the 100m, 200m & 400m
- Junior Men may also compete as senior in the jumps, 800m & 1500m
- Masters Men may also compete as senior in the jumps, 800m & 1500m
- Masters Men O35, O40 & O45 may also compete as senior in the throws events
- Where athletes more than one category, the entry fee for both categories, must be paid, *i.e.* if competing in the senior & masters 800m, a €10 {2x€5} entry fee will apply.

Eligibility:

- Eligibility for Senior: Athletes born in 1994, 1993....
- Eligibility for Junior: Athletes born in 1995-1991

 Masters Categories start at O35, O40..... Men & Women

Guests are welcome to participate in these championships but must be registered with the AAI and enter through the competition secretary.

Club Colours must be worn.
