# Billy Gallagher and Sheila Curtin triumph in the fourth adidas Cork City Marathon

The fourth staging of the adidas Cork City Marathon, which this year was known as the adidas Cork 800 Marathon, had approximately 1,000 runners in the line up. A notable absentee was the 1983 and 1984 champion, Jerry Kiernan. Very mild Spring conditions greeted the runners as the Lord Mayor, Ald. Liam Burke, fired the cannon for the start.

From the outset the pre race favourites, Billy Gallagher and world veterans marathon champion, Pat Murphy surged to the front. The leaders reeled off miles of 4:58, 5:22, 5:18, 5:13, 5:15, 5:21, 5:13, 5:23 and 5:19 to reach 9 miles in 47:22. At this stage only John Buckley remained with Gallagher and Murphy but as the leaders turned into Melbourne after a 5:18 tenth mile Buckley lost contact. The two-man contest was now in full swing and for the next thirteen miles there was nothing between them. The leaders went through halfway in 68:23 and the pace at this stage was for a 2:16.45 marathon. The momentum was maintained along the Quays and down the Centre Park Road with the three miles from McCurtain Street to the Marina occupying a swift 15:46.

Murphy was the first to wilt under the pressure as a gap appeared on the Marina. However, by the time 20 miles was reached in Blackrock, Murphy was back in contention. At 21 miles on the Skehard Road Murphy endeavoured to break Gallagher but despite miles of 5:13 and 5:14 Gallagher held the pace. With less than 3 miles to go Gallagher surged and Murphy relinquished the battle. Although the pace dropped considerably to 5:30 miling on the Douglas Road Murphy was unable to regain form to catch Gallagher who coasted home a clear winner in 2:18.58 with Murphy second in 2:19.52.

Almost 7 mins. elapsed before the third runner passed the finish line

outside the Imperial Hotel. In fifth place was Derry O'Driscoll who ran a personal best in 2:29.56. The 47-year-old CMP Chief knocked almost 4 minutes off his personal best. As veterans both Murphy and O'Driscoll performances were world class. In the ladies' section Sheila Curtin ran out an easy winner by almost 3 mins. in 3:01.23. She ran comfortably until 20 miles when she went through a bad patch. Having stopped and walked for a while she was passed by Catherine Speight. However, she overcame the crises, regained her composure and ran on to a comfortable victory. Marion Lyons was third and Rose Crockett fourth.

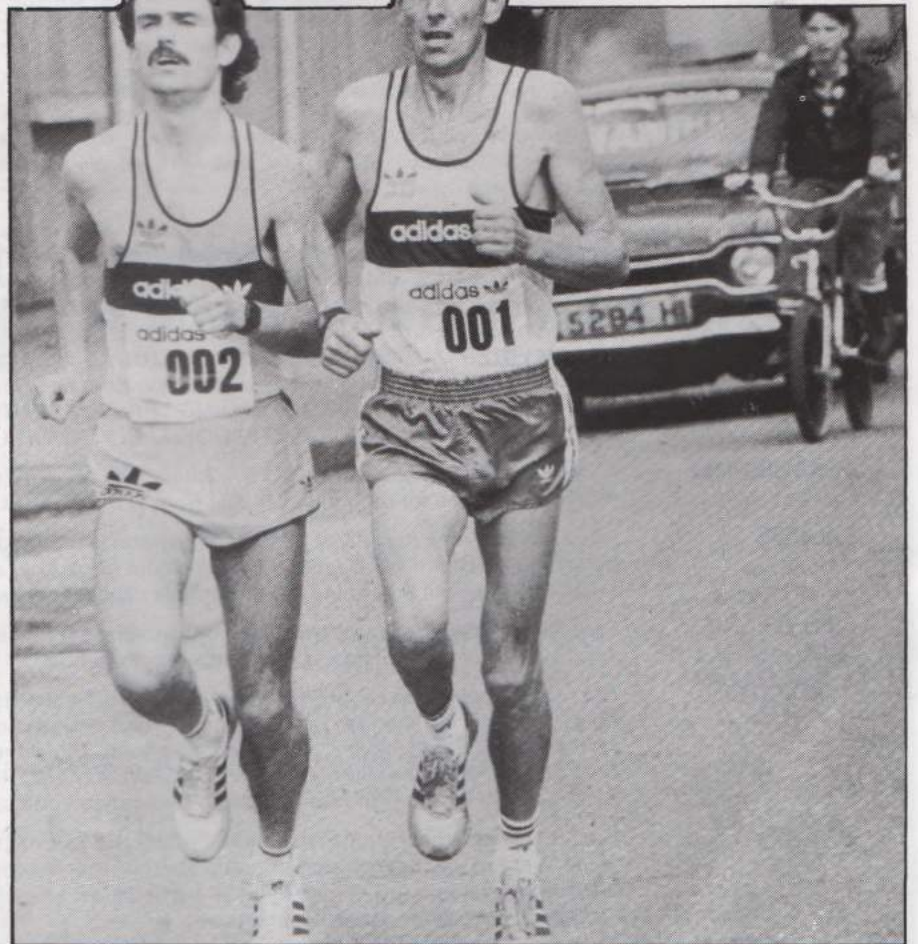

We have secured a sufficient number of guaranteed entries for the run, and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. The entry fee is £28.00 per person and this includes a Coach transfer to the start, and invitations to specific Marathon events. No entries will be accepted from persons under 16 years of age. No qualification standards have been set and the race is open to all. All entrants must furnish the required information on the Marathon Entry form.

**ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY JULY 15th NEXT.**

Registration of entrants will take place in New York on Friday and Saturday, October 25th and 26th. AS TORCTRAVEL IS NOW THE LEADING TRAVEL AGENT OPERATING TOURS TO THE MARATHON, IT IS ESSENTIAL TO BOOK EARLY TO ENSURE YOU OBTAIN A RACE ENTRY.

**PASSPORT/VISA**

A valid, up to date Passport and U.S. Visitors Visa are required to enter the United States. Application forms for both are available from TORCTRAVEL.

**TO BOOK:**

A Non-Refundable deposit of £85.00 per person is required to secure a firm place on the Tour. Balance of payment will be due 8 weeks before departure, and late payment without contacting TROCTRAVEL, will be grounds for automatic cancellation without further notice.

**TRAVEL INSURANCE:**

Fully comprehensive Travel Insurance is available at a rate of £21.50 per person for cover up to 9 days. While not compulsory, it is strongly recommended.

**OUR HOTELS:**

The main Hotel which we will be using for the Tour is the Hotel Wentworth, 59 West 46th Street, New York. **CURRENCY:**

**DESCRIPTION OF THE MARATHON COURSE:**

Dual starts on the Staten Island side of the Verrazano Bridge, utilizing both the Brooklyn bound and Staten Island bound lanes. Both groups will merge at the 8 mile mark at 4th Avenue and Flatbush Avenue in Brooklyn. Proceed through Brooklyn along Bedford Avenue to Queens. Across Queensboro Bridge into Manhattan on 1st Avenue to Willis Bridge into the Bronx along 138th Street. Cross Madison Avenue Bridge into Manhattan at Fifth Avenue into Central Park at 102nd Street. Exit Park at 59th Street and Central Park South and re-enter Park at Columbus Circle and finish at 66th Street in front of Tavern-On-The-Green.

\*Due to construction, parts of the course in Brooklyn between mile 8 and 11 may be changed.

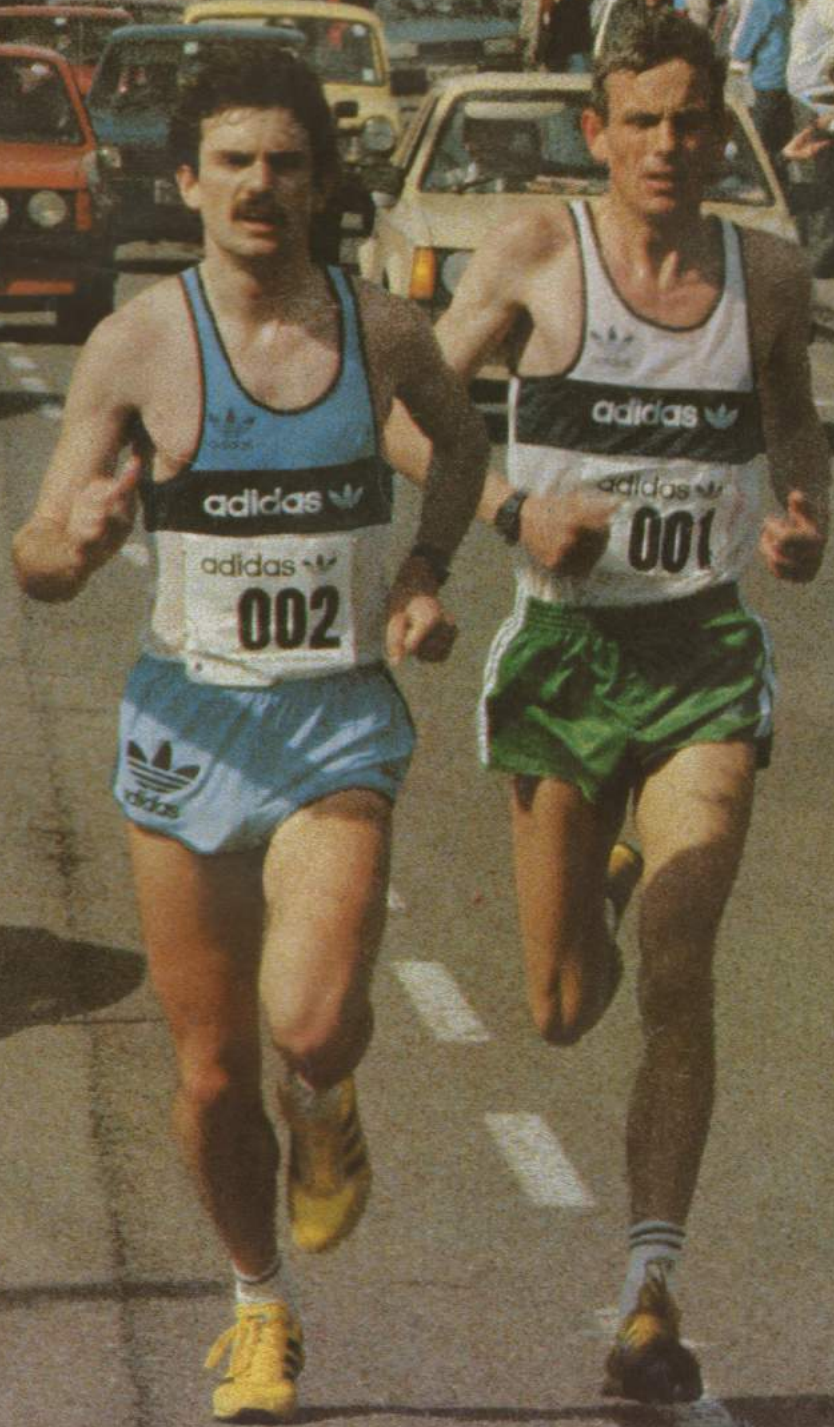
