Phil Healy.....Bandon A.C.

Phil set a new National 100m record of 11.28 seconds in Santry in June 2018.

She now holds both the 100m and 200m National Records. Phil ran a 400m PB of 52.19 seconds in Geneva. In the 200m - 23.17 seconds.

Phil finished fourth in her 200m semi final last August at the European Athletics Championships. She placed 11th overall.

Prior to this she set a new National Record at the Cork City Sports in July 2018, setting a new record of 22.99 seconds in the 200m.

Phil Healy was a member of the Irish Women's 4 x 100m Relay team.

Masters Over 50 Cross Country

Carmel placed 2nd in the World Cross Country In Malaga.

She also placed 3rd in 10k Road Race.

In Swansea, Carmel placed 2nd for silver, she was also the first Irish scorer for the Irish Team, which placed 2nd overall.

Rory O'Sullivan from St. Finbarr's was selected to represent Ireland on the O40 team at the British and Irish Masters Cross Country Championships in Swansea, Wales on 17 November

last year.

Laura Nicholson was selected and competed in the Women's Under 20 Cross

Country Championships at Tilburg, The Netherlands last December 9th, 2018.

Joe Cunningham.....St. Finbnarr's A.C.

Joe Cunningham was selected to represent Ireland at the British and Irish Masters Cross Country Championships in Swansea, Wales on 17 November last year. Joe scored on the O45 Men's team which finished second overall.

Darragh McElhinney......Bantry A.C.

In July, Darragh was one of two male athletes who qualified to represent Ireland in the World Junior U20 Championships in Finland, He competed in the 5000 metre race which was dominated by African athletes.

In December represented Ireland in the European Cross Country Championships in Tilburg, Holland finishing in 16th place, leading the Irish team to a 5th place finish. On the back of this performance he represented Europe on the Junior Mixed Relay Team in the Simply Health Stirling Great X country in Stirling, Scotland.

Paul Moloney......Mallow A.C.

Paul had another great year following on from 2017. He ran the European master's cross country in Madrid in March, led the Irish team to sliver and was selected for the Irish team for the British and Irish Masters Cross Country in Swansea in November, finishing 3rd on the Irish silver winning team.

Breda (Gaffney) Walsh....Mallow A.C.

Breda had a fantastic year in 2018 which was capped by selection for the Irish team for the British and Irish Masters Cross Country in Swansea. Breda also won a silver medal in Swansea as part of the Irish over 45 team.

Kathleen O.Brien.....St. Catherine's A.C.

Kathleen represented Ireland at the British and Irish masters international in Swansea; last November.
Kathleen finished 7th and was part of the over 70 team that was 2nd on the day. Another great performance by Kathleen.

Represented Ireland at the British and Irish Masters Cross Country Championships. He was also selected to compete the European Masters Cross Country.

Honouring Cork 1967 Wining Team

Cork regained the all-Ireland senior title at Tullamore taking the first three places and six finishing in the first twelve. This was the fourth title to come to Cork in five years!

John Buckley (St Finbarr's)

Became only the second Cork man to win all-Ireland cross country when in 1967 and again in 1972 he won both inter club and inter county titles in the same year. Munster champion in 67 and 71. Was a scoring member of the Cork Junior winning team of 64, a scoring member of the Cork senior winning team of 64, 65, 67

and 68 Three times Cork Cross country champion (The youngest man to win the title). Also Cork Junior and Novice champion in 64.

Donie Walsh (Fr. Mathews)

18 year old Donie Walsh was the youngest member of the 67 team having finished second in the previous week's All-Ireland Junior he went on to finish second in the Senior Race. Later he went on to win all Irelands senior titles in 73, 73, 74, 76, 78. Member Cork winning teams 67, 68, 73. Won Irish Titles in 10K and the Marathon. Four times Cork Senior Cross Country Champion, Novice County Champion in 1966, Intermediate Champion 1967.

Mattie Murphy (Rising Sun),

Mattie finished third in 1967 Member of 1962
Junior winning team and Senior teams of 1964, 65, 67, 68. Won Cork County Championship in 1964, 67, 68, 70. Novice County Champion 1962. Won Munster Senior Cross Country 1970. Winning Track

all-Ireland 10 mile champion 1968, 4 mile in 1964, 4 miles in 1966.

Willie Webb (Rising Sun),


Winner of All Ireland junior 1962 third in all-Ireland senior 1962 second Senior in 1963, member of 1963, 64 Senior teams and 67, 1971 NACAI. Won Munster

Senior 1963, 64, won Munster Junior 1962. Winner of Cork Senior Championship 1962, Member of Rising Sun winning Cork Senior County Championship 1963, Junior County Champion 1961. A member of the Cork NACAI winning team of 1970.

Pat O'Reardon (UCC/White's Cross)

Member of Cork winning teams 67 68 and 72. Won Irish Steeplechase title 1971, 5000m 1973. A Member of first Leevale team to win Cork Senior Title in 1968. Won all-Ireland hurling medals with Cork minors in 64 and U21



Member of winning 1962 Junior Cork team, member of Cork Senior winning team of 1963 64, 65 67,71 NACAI. Won Cork County Junior Championship in 1962. John was the only scoring member of all four 63-67 teams. A member of Cork NACAI winning

team of 1970.

Willie Joe Shine (Millstreet)

Member of 1962 Junior winning team. Scoring member of senior teams in 1964 and 65 senior non soring 67, NACAI Cork winning team 71. Member elip team that wen three Cork County Senior title in

of the Meelin team that won three Cork County Senior title in 1960, 61, 62. He was a member of Millstreet 64 team who won the Cork County Senior Cross Country Championship.

Jackie O Callaghan (Hilltown)

Member of Junior winning teams of 1964, Senior teams in 1964, 67, 68 and 73. Jackie was the first winner of the Cork Intermediate Championship in 1964. He was a member of the first Leevale team to

win the Cork County Senior Championship in 1968.

Dennis Buckley (St. Finbarr's)

Like his brother John he was a scoring member of the junior and senior teams of 1964 and a member 67 and 68, also a member of the 68 team. Winning all-Ireland 880 Yards in 1965. Won a number of Munster and Cork titles in that same event.

Pat O'Connell (Blarney)

Finished fourth in the first ever U20 all-Ireland Cross Country in a race won by his Blarney clubmate Richie Crowley from Donie Walsh leading Munster to victory. He finished second in Irish Junior Championship 1968. Third in Irish Intermediate Championship 1970.

Pat O'Connell (Blarney)

later a member of Cork NACAI 1970 winning Cork team.

Freddie Walsh (Youghal)

Won an all-Ireland Junior with Cork 1966 Won Munster Novice and junior medals in 1966 Member of the Youghal team which won Cork Novice Junior and Intermediate titles in 1966
