WATERS CUP

A Very Hearty Welcome is once more extended to the team of U.S.A. Servicemen who have come over from England to compete in the International Services Contest against the Irish Army. We hope our American guests will greatly enjoy their visit to our city.

WATERS of Cork generously presented a handsome Cup in 1954 for this Contest. That year it was won by the U.S.A. Air Force Team. In 1955 and 1956 the Waters Cup was won by the Irish Army but was "captured" again by the 'invaders' in 1957 and 1958, being regained in 1959 by the Irish Army who again won in 1960 to take the lead. The U.S. Team evened the score in 1961, making it four wins to each side, but went into the lead again in 1962. Yet, the Irish Army levelled the score in 1963 and again went into the lead in 1964 and scored a further win in 1965.

Will the American Team win back the Waters Cup this year? We are delighted to hear that their team will be at full strength, drawn from the complete European Command.
